

MAINLAND UNITED SOCCER SCHOLARSHIPS

Mainland United Soccer Association strives to provide high level soccer training for an affordable price to all children. While MUSA fees are near the lowest fees in the state, still some families still can not afford the fees associated with playing. MUSA will provide reduced fees and complete scholarships to players. The basis for awarding of the scholarships will be need, community service and giving back to the game.

MUSA is a volunteer run organization and many volunteer positions offer reduced or no fees for the time you put into the program. The manner, skills, and services that you can provide MUSA should be outlined and attached to the application on additional pages. MUSA prefers to not provide free play to players and views applications for partial payments request and/or volunteered in kind services more favorably.

Eligibility

- Players must attend tryouts and be play on a MUSA travel team.
- Be a resident of Linwood, Northfield, or Somers Point preferred but not required.
- Demonstrate active service to his or her family and community and a strong desire to give back to the game of soccer.

Application Procedure

An applicant must include all of the following:

- 1. a completed application;
- 2. description of volunteer services provided to the club or offered. Club needs help running its recreation program by setting up and breaking down goals on Fridays or Saturdays.

Completed applications must be submitted no later than June 1 for fall season and December 1 for spring season. Applications will be reviewed by the MUSA Board of Directors.
